ATLANTIC – Cass County Health System announces that an H1N1 influenza vaccination clinic will be conducted on Tuesday, November 10 from 4 – 7 pm in the Cass County Memorial Hospital atrium. This H1N1 influenza vaccination clinic will be held for those in the **H1N1 influenza priority groups** including:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel
- Persons between the ages of 6 months and 4 years of age
- Persons from ages 5 years through 64 years who are at higher risk for novel H1N1 influenza because of chronic health disorders or compromised immune systems.

This clinic will only offer the injectable form of H1N1 vaccine, which anyone in the above priority groups can receive. There will not be any nasal mist vaccine.

Cass County Health System has prioritized the use of their supply of H1N1 influenza vaccine according to Centers for Disease Control guidelines to ensure that those most at risk receive the vaccine.
