Tips & Tricks

- Pack separate bags for you and for baby. With separate bags, it will be easier for you to find what you need quickly.
- Use your diaper bag to pack for baby. When you leave the hospital, you'll leave with some basic care items (bulb syringe, wipes, etc.) that are great to have stashed in the diaper bag. We will also supply diapers, wipes, and formula while you're at the hospital, and you'll be able to take those items home with you.
- Pack a mesh laundry bag or a plastic bag. At the hospital you can stash dirty clothes and blankets in the bag. When you unpack at home, you can easily sort what needs to go straight to the laundry.
- Buy travel-size hygiene products. You'll be able to pack those ahead of time, so you don't have to worry about packing your own toiletries at the last minute.
- Make a list of your questions and concerns. While you're at Cass Health, our nurses and doctors are here to help you learn and become confident about caring for your newborn. No question or concern is too small or silly — if it's of concern to you, then it's of concern to us, too.
